

Printing Guidelines

Applications supported:

We support files in the following applications: Adobe Illustrator, InDesign, Photoshop & Quark Xpress

EPS files supplied from other applications may be used but please be aware that we will print these as supplied and cannot be held responsible for any errors.

Fonts:

Please make us aware if your artwork contains any special characters or ligatures. All fonts in print ready artwork must be converted to outlines.

Transparency & Gradient Meshes:

Any elements within a document which use transparency or gradient meshes should be rasterised or flattened.

Visuals:

Up to date colour visuals must be supplied for all jobs. This will ensure that you receive the correct prints. Any artwork uploaded to our ftp site must have a PDF visual to accompany them.

Image Bleed:

Allow a minimum of 3mm bleed on all documents

Colour Matching:

As standard we match as close as possible any pantone colour references in your documents.

If you have a specific pantone refs that must be exact please make us aware of these. A colour test can be supplied to you before the job goes to print.

Resolution:

Scans should be supplied at a minimum of 100 dpi.

All images and documents are checked and will be sent as a PDF proof to you before printing.

How to get you files to us:

You can supply your files on a CD, DVD, Hard Disk, email (up to 10mb).
